Minutes

Tuesday March 12th, 4:30Pm 2024 Village Board Room

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 4:30pm by Chairman Witzke. Present were Trustee Kubasta, Trustee Girouard, Trustee Foster and Chief Sauriol.

Approve February 14th, 2023, PSC meeting minutes: Trustee Kubasta motioned to approve. Trustee Girouard seconded it. All ayes.

Old Business

Chief Sauriol stated the Flock cameras have been ordered and they are currently in the permit process stage. Chief Sauriol stated he was able to get 14 business to donate to the cameras for this year. Chairman Witzke stated this is something that the board may consider funding for 2025 and stated this is a good thing for the village.

Chief Sauriol asked the committee what they would like to see for a fee for mooring a boat for 48 hours or longer at the public docks. The committee stated \$50.00 would be fair. Trustee Foster stated he would run it by the Park Committee as he is the chairman of that.

Chief Sauriol discussed the status of the 2024 budget thus far. He stated based on the Workhorse printouts, it appears the overall police budget is on track and around 22% for the first quarter.

New Business

Chief Sauriol stated there appears to be a need for a 3-Way stop at E. Main St at N. 9th St given the amount of the cars that get jammed up on N. 9th Av after school. The committee asked Chief Sauriol to contact DOT to see if their thoughts are because STH 116 is controlled by the state.

Chief Sauriol stated he has received a couple of complaints about speeders on S. 4th St before Grant St and has been asked to put in a 4-way stop at S 4th St at Cleveland St. Chief Sauriol stated he would monitor the area and said it's not a bad idea to have a 4-way stop sign there but that there are many stop signs as it is in that area.

Chief Sauriol asked the committee what they felt would be a fair fine amount for those violating the 48-hour consecutive boat mooring ordinance. Trustee Girouard stated he would like to see higher fines. Chief Sauriol will come up with a forfeiture schedule.
