YTD we have spent \$18,379.47 of the \$210,363.86 for a total of 8.74% of the current budget

- **Key Events**

- Received a boat wash station quote with Ventek north of \$10,000, reviewing the option again of a coin operated mechanism
- Beach House was cleaned out by Public Works crews, and demolished by Miron contractors.
- Dock at LWP is in.
- Starting to open the parks with garbage cans, swings, pickleball nets etc. waiting to turn on the water to ensure we are past freezing temperatures
- Ordered the Landscape boulders and fieldstone for the landscape project inside the fence at the beach house, grass and shrubs will be ordered tomorrow, area is to wet to begin any work at this time.
- Opening the park shelters for the season
- Begin grass cutting operations
- Begin moving fill for the landscaping at the beach house

- **Stats**

Addition of sand and Maintenance to the LWP Beach

- Roto till the beach 2 a week and remove weeds and debris
Labor 4 hrs per week for 16 weeks 31.99/hr total \$2047.36
 - Expand the beach approx. 500 square feet
 - 22 tons of sand \$580
 - 12 hrs of labor \$383.88
 - Total \$963.88
- **Work Orders**
 - Discussed a work order where a resident requested signs placed on the ends of the fishing piers to deter people from casting fishing gear into the navigation channel in the river between the two fishing piers, it was also discussed that the village should provide information to those at the time of purchase of a pier pin.
