NOTICE TO DESTROY NOXIOUS WEEDS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to each and every person who owns, occupies, or controls land in the Village of Winneconne, Wisconsin, that they are required by state law to destroy all noxious weeds on such property before the plants bloom.

Noxious weeds include, but are not limited to:

- Canada thistle
- Leafy spurge
- Field bindweed (creeping Jenny)
- Musk thistle
- Bull thistle
- Plumeless thistle
- Multiflora rose
- Purple loosestrife
- Any other weeds designated as noxious by Wisconsin law.

Destruction of noxious weeds.

Notice is further given that if the owner, occupant, or person in control of the land fails to destroy such weeds, the Village of Winneconne may cause the weeds to be destroyed and the cost of destruction plus administrative costs may be assessed against the property as provided by law.
